- (b) Suggest a suitable statistical method and portray South Africa's balance of visible trade. (08 marks)
- (c) Identify the years in which South Africa's balance of visible trade was;

- (ii) favourable (01 mark)
- (d) Give the demerits of using such a statistical method in representing such data. (02 marks)
- (e) Assess the contribution of such a trade in the economy of South Africa. (06marks)

7. To what extent has the presence of raw materials encouraged the distribution of manufacturing industries in **either** South Africa **or** France? (25 marks)
8. Examine the conditions that have led to low level of Agricultural modernization in **either** Zambia **or** China. (25 marks)
